During the late 1970's, Atascocita began to grow as a community, as did their needs as a community. **Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department** purchased their first fire engine, a 1976 Ford Firefox pumper, and was originally housed at the Humble Fire Department's Station 2 on Wilson Road. In 1978, **Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department** was incorporated in the State of Texas and a new station house was built on the corner of Farmingham Road and Walden Forest Drive, where it still stands today. The **AVFD** has grown considerably and now has three (3) station houses located in Atascocita.

**Project Start Conditions/Repelling Tower Surface Preparation Started**



**Scope Sequence**

1. Shot blasted floor (100%)
2. Concrete floor imperfections (holes and cracks filled with **E31-1204** epoxy crack filler
3. **E31-1202-64** penetrating epoxy primer applied (3-5 mils DFT)
4. **E31-1202** 100% solids epoxy applied (20-30 mils DFT)
5. Two (2) applications of **U31-1201** linear urethane applied
6. Logos and stripes installed
7. Clean up
