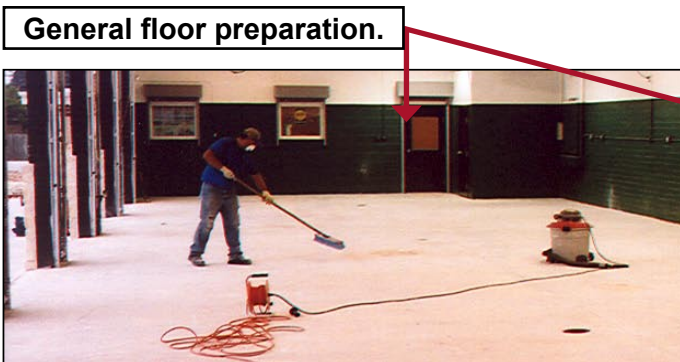

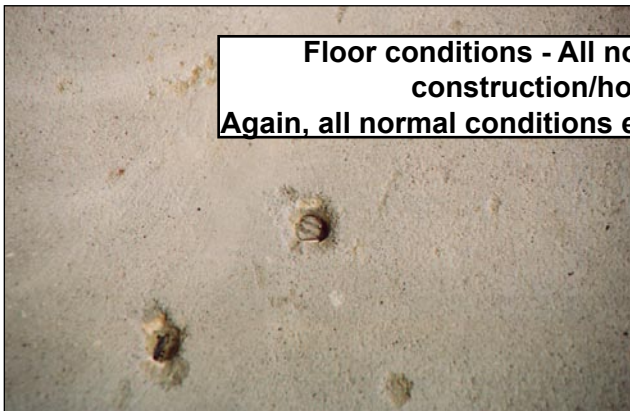

Floor conditions - All normal. These are expected construction/holes/imperfections. Again, all normal conditions expected for a construction site.



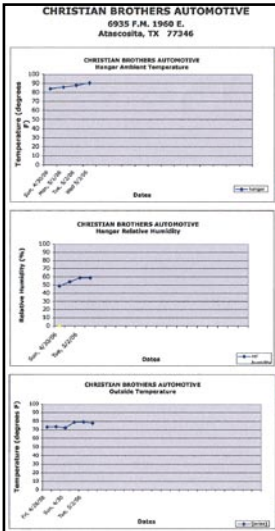

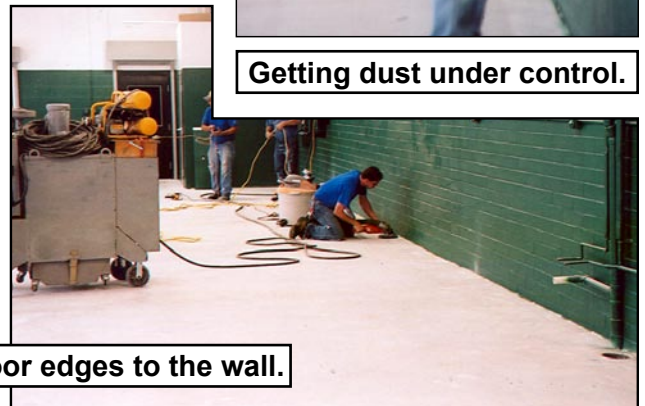

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: This product is a low solids, penetrating polyamide epoxy primer. It is used to prime concrete and steel surfaces before the application of a topcoat. The primer is suitable for use on all types of concrete and steel surfaces.			
COMPOSITION: This product is a two-part system consisting of a base resin and a hardener. The base resin is a low solids, penetrating polyamide epoxy. The hardener is a polyamide curing agent.			
APPLICATION: This product is applied by hand brush, roller, or spray. It is used to prime concrete and steel surfaces before the application of a topcoat. The primer is suitable for use on all types of concrete and steel surfaces.			
PREPARATION: The surface to be primed must be clean, dry, and free of oil, grease, and other contaminants. The surface must be roughened to a minimum of 1/16 inch (1.6 mm) and then dusted.			
MIXING: The base resin and hardener must be mixed in the ratio of 10 parts resin to 1 part hardener by volume. The mixture must be stirred thoroughly before use.			
COATING: The primer is applied in a single coat. The thickness of the coat should be 1/16 inch (1.6 mm). The primer should be allowed to cure for 24 hours before the application of a topcoat.			
STORAGE: This product should be stored in a cool, dry place. The shelf life of the product is 12 months from the date of manufacture.			
SAFETY: This product is flammable and should be used in a well-ventilated area. It should be kept away from heat, sparks, and open flames. It should be stored in a fire-resistant container.			
ENVIRONMENTAL: This product is low in VOC content and is suitable for use in areas with strict VOC regulations.			

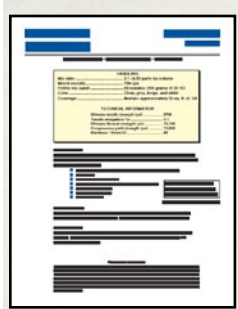
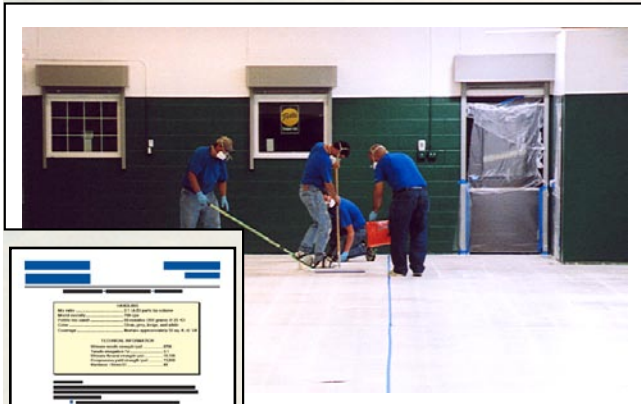

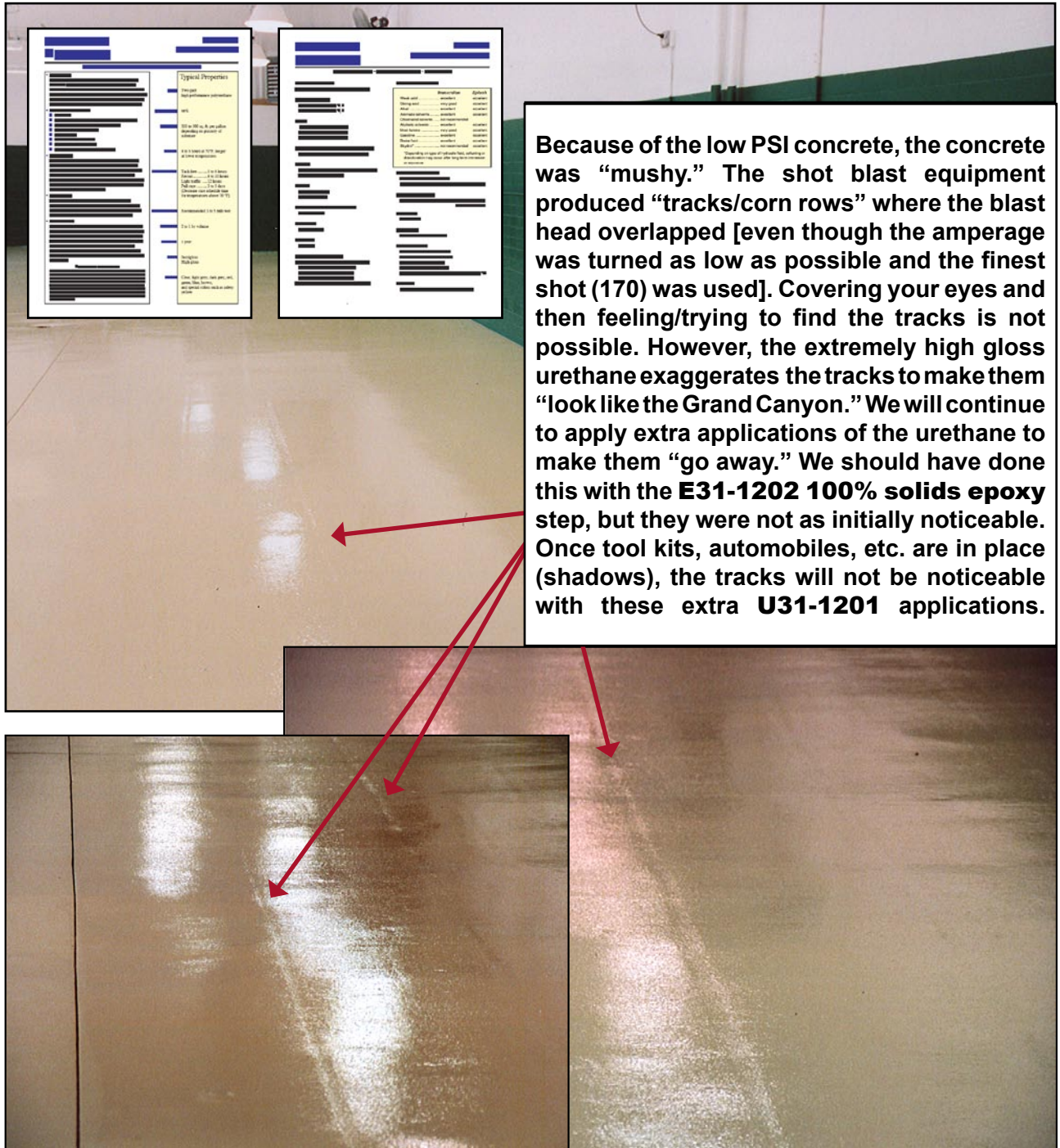
Floor primed with **E31-1202-64** (64% solids primer).



E31-1202 100% solids epoxy being squeegeed and back rolled.



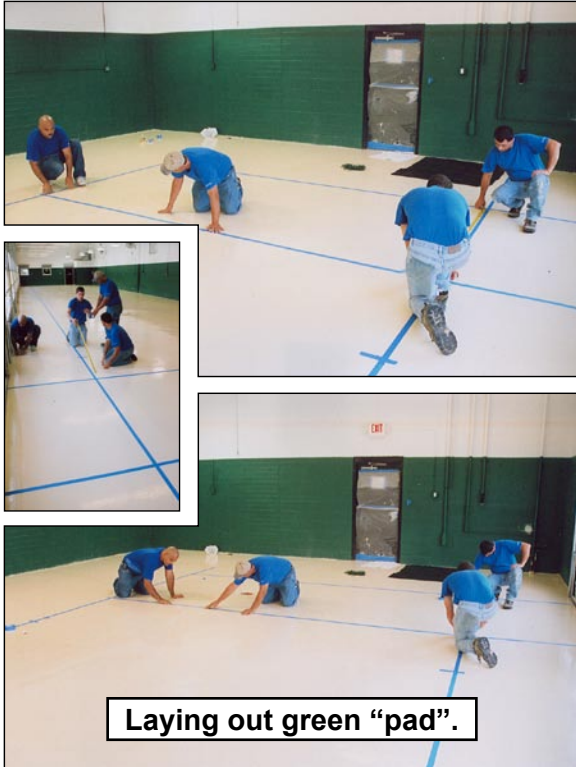

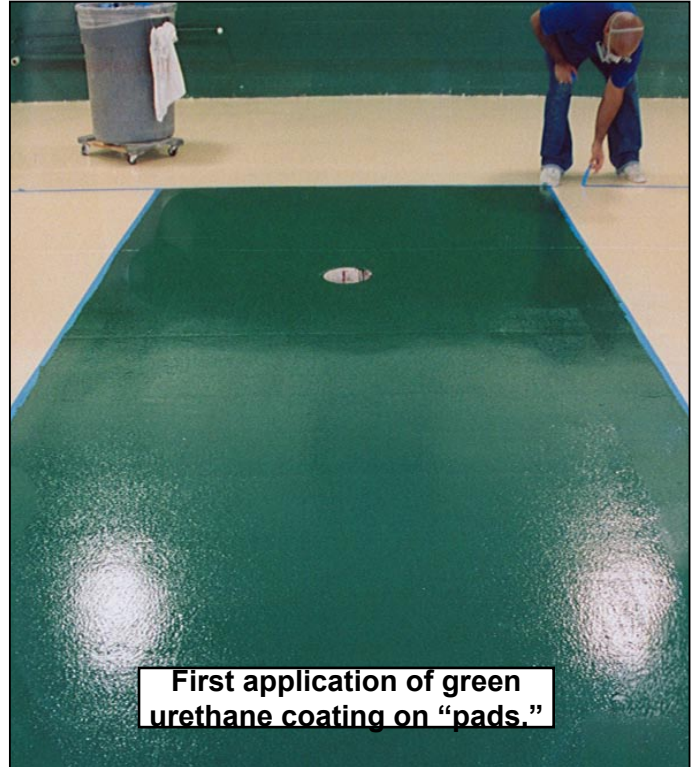

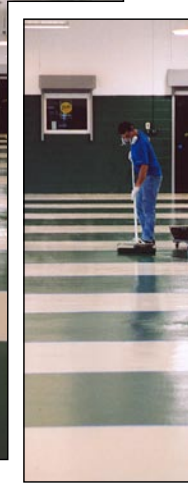
