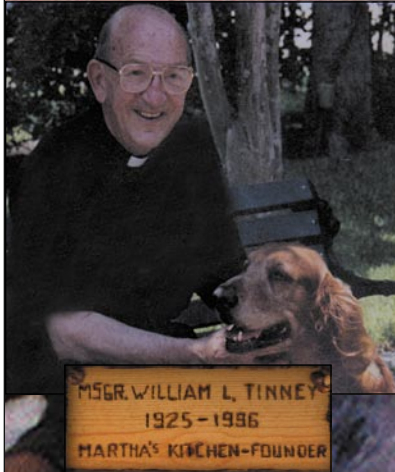


A New Kitchen Floor

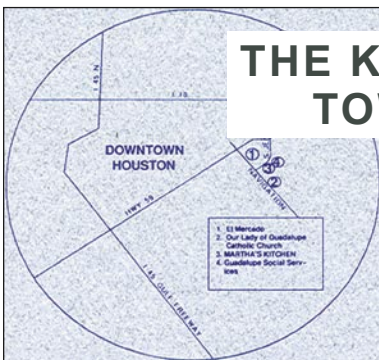
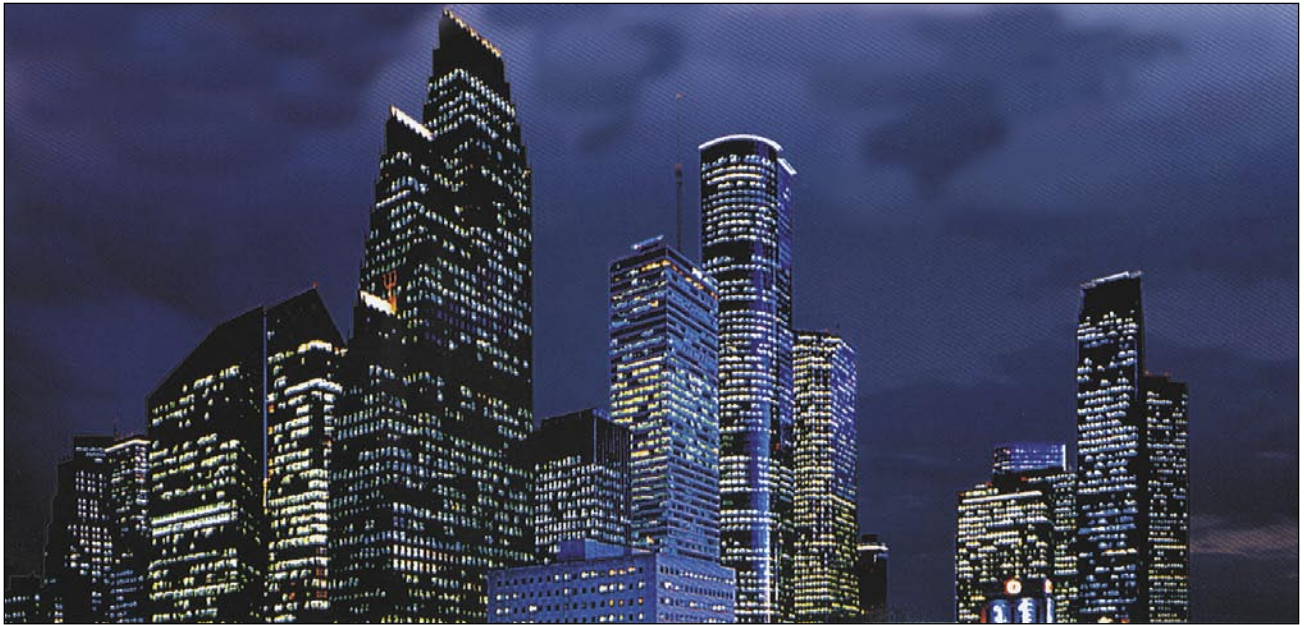
A new kitchen floor for an inner city soup kitchen
